Within the context of its acquisitions policy, so far this year the EIFFAGE group has acquired or is in the process of acquiring 12 companies generating full-year sales of around €230 million and operating profit of around €30 million, employing just under 2,000 people, half of them in Europe, for a total investment of approximately €150 million.

EIFFEL has acquired GOYER, the French market leader in curtain walls and high-quality aluminium fittings. A family company formed in 1931, GOYER posted sales in 2004 in excess of €70 million and has 300 employees.

APPIA, the road construction division of EIFFAGE, has boosted its presence in Spain and its building materials production capacity with the acquisition of GRAVERA DEL JARAMA, one of the country's leading gravel producers. Based to the south of Madrid, GRAVERA DEL JARAMA produces over 2 million tonnes of aggregates annually. It owns authorised reserves of 30 million tonnes and has supplementary reserves of 13 million tonnes. In addition, negotiations are underway for the acquisition of a majority holding in a Portuguese road construction company generating sales of around €25 million.

FORCLUM is expected to take control in the next few weeks of two companies in Belgium, an electrical maintenance and installation company and an air conditioning specialist, generating overall sales of around €80 million and with 635 employees.

These two transactions will boost FORCLUM'S presence in the French-speaking part of Belgium through its subsidiary FEYENS and give it access to the important market in the Brussels region.

EIFFAGE CONSTRUCTION is finalising the takeover of three companies in France, Monaco and Luxembourg. They are specialised in building and river works and have combined sales of around €40 million.

When required, these transactions have been submitted for approval to the competition authorities.
